Requirements

- Tennis Australia Coach Member
- Tennis Australia Club Professional qualified (or higher)
- Primary Coach, as defined by the principal individual responsible for the athlete's development, substantiated by an average of twice weekly coaching frequency
- An active and longstanding coaching relationship must exist, with a working relationship of minimum 12 months prior to the player achieving the performance result
- Both the coach and players represent the sport of tennis to the highest standard
