<p>Visual acuity is a measure of the eye's ability to see fine detail clearly and is the prime measure of clarity of vision. <p>Field of Vision is the ability to see objects to the side, when looking straight ahead.</p> <p>The following requirement must be met:</p> <p>Normal to confrontation in both eyes (see for example www.nlm.nih.gov/medlineplus/ency/article/003879.htm)</p>										
Near Vision	Optometrist's comments	Verified ✓								
<p>Chair Umpires are required to be able to see at near as well as at distance.
