Visa applications may take up to 4 weeks to be processed by the Australian Government. Invitation letters will be issued only to genuine players and support staff members with a regular playing history.

First Day/Time a player can arrive on site for practice: Saturday 9 September, 9am

Matches will start each day from 3pm and continue under lights across all the match courts. Full player services on site will commence each match day from 1pm and run through to the conclusion of matches with practice courts available from 10am each day. Accommodation in the Darwin area is limited and advanced bookings and checking of conditions of bookings is recommended. Transport will commence from 12 noon until the conclusion of matches and will be available to the official hotel and other hotels only within 8 kilometres from venue taking in neighbouring suburbs such as Coconut Grove, Parap and Nightcliff. Transport will not take in the Darwin CBD or the Mindil Beach areas. Accommodation is also available at the airport hotels including the Mercure and Novotel Airport Hotels which are 1 kilometre from the venue and next to the airport. Practice balls will be available on-site from the day before qualifying. Prior to this day they will be available for purchase at the host venue and court hire fees will apply. Prizemoney will be paid in AUD bank transfer. Draws, order of play and other circuit tournament information, local guide and visitor information and accommodation available on www.tennis.com.au/protour.

Alternative travel options: From airport, exit terminal and continue on Henry Wrigley Drive, turning right at Abala Road. Venue is immediately on left.
