## TENNIS AUSTRALIA TRADE PROMOTION: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. These Terms and Conditions (Terms) must be read together with the Schedule for the Competition, which defines certain terminology used in these Terms. Entry into the Competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms.

### **Eligibility to enter**

2. Entry is only open to persons residing in the Location who comply with the Entry Restrictions (if any). Entrants can only enter in their own name. The Promoter may require the winner to provide proof of age, identity and residential address, to claim the Prize, at the Promoter's discretion. If a winner cannot provide suitable proof, the winner will forfeit the Prize in whole and no substitute will be offered. Entrants may submit the Maximum number of entries.
3. Officers, contractors, employees and their immediate families of the Promoter or any of its related bodies corporates, or of its agencies or contractors involved with this Competition are ineligible to enter.

### **Entry**

4. To enter the Competition, you must follow the Entry Method during the Competition Period. All entries received after this time are ineligible for entry into the Competition and late, incomplete, incorrectly submitted, illegible, corrupted or misdirected entries won't be accepted.
5. No entry fee is charged by the Promoter to enter the Promotion.
6. All eligible entrants will go into consideration for the Winner Determination.
7. The Prize will be awarded to the valid entrant(s) which best meet the judgement details set out in the Winner Determination.
8. The Promoter's decision and all matters pertaining to this Competition will be final. No correspondence will be entered into.

### **Prize**

10. The Prize and Total Prize Pool are specified in the Schedule.
11. The Prize is not transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash. The Prize values are accurate at the date of commencement of the Competition. The Promoter and United States Tennis Association Incorporated (USTA) accept no responsibility for any variation in the value of a prize after that date. Refunds will not be made in respect to unused services or prizes. Refunds will not be issued for unused services or Prizes. Where the Prize (or any part) is unavailable, the Promoter may substitute the Prize (or part) with a Prize (or part) of equal or greater value subject to any regulations in the Location.
12. If a winner does not claim or use an element of the Prize then that element of the Prize will be forfeited by the winner.
13. All costs associated with the Prize not specifically included in the Prize Details including, but not limited to, any transport costs, transfer costs, meals, taxes, insurance and other ancillary costs are the responsibility of the winner (and their companion(s) if applicable).

No compensation will be paid in lieu of US Open ticket prizes that cannot be used for any reason, including but not limited to cancellation of the US Open. US Open ticket prizes may not be used for advertising, promotions (including contests or sweepstakes) or other trade purposes without the prior express written consent of the USTA. Tickets to the US Open are subject to all ticket terms and conditions as well as facility rules and regulations.
19. US Open tickets are subject to all ticket terms and conditions, as well as all venue and US Open procedures, policies, protocols and mitigation measures, including, without limitation, security and guest conduct, health and safety, and applicable bag policies, and ticket holders must comply and abide by all such terms, conditions, procedures, policies, protocols and mitigation measures.

#### **Notification and collection of Prizes and redraw process**

20. The winner(s) will be notified in accordance with the Notification of Winners section of the Schedule and have their details published in the manner set out in the Publication Details (if applicable).
21. The winner(s) must confirm their eligibility and contact the Promoter by the Prize Claim Date and Time. If a winner is unable to be contacted, and all methods of communication are unsuccessful, the relevant winner's entry will be invalidated and the Promoter will conduct such further Unclaimed Prize Determinations as necessary to award the relevant Prize, subject to any regulations in the Location. 22. 23. The Promoter's Privacy Policy contains a list of Australian Tennis Organisations and information about how you may access and seek correction of your personal information or complain about a breach of your privacy by the Promoter, and how the Promoter will deal with that complaint. The Promoter may from time to time disclose your personal information to third party service providers, for example IT service providers, in order to provide services to you. Such third parties may be located overseas (as further detailed in TA's Privacy Policy).
24. If you provide someone else's details as part of your entry or to redeem the Prize, you must ensure that you have their permission to do so and that they provide the same consent as detailed in the previous paragraph.

25. This Competition is not sponsored, endorsed, administered by or associated with Facebook, Instagram or any other platform where it is promoted.

#### **Discontinuance and disqualification of Competition**

26. The Promoter may, acting reasonably, cancel, modify or suspend the Competition and invalidate any affected entries, or suspend, modify or replace the Prize (provided that any substitute Prize is of the same or greater value as the original Prize), if for whatever reason the Competition does not run as planned, subject to any regulations in the Location. This includes but is not limited to scenarios in which:
- a) the Competition or Prize (or any part) becomes unlawful, or would expose or put the Promoter in breach of any law or regulation, or subject to any regulatory inquiry or investigation;
  - b) the Competition or Prize (or any part) becomes unsafe for any reason;
  - c) the Prize (or any part) becomes unavailable;
  - d) an event in connection with the Competition is cancelled or rescheduled;
  - e) an operational or technical failure occurs;
  - f) the Promoter reasonably consider a conflict of interest has arisen;

27. The Promoter may, acting reasonably, disqualify your entry if it is objectionable, profane, potentially insulting, inflammatory, defamatory or not compliant with these Terms or if you have engaged in conduct in entering the Competition which is fraudulent, misleading, deceptive or generally damaging to the goodwill or reputation of the Competition and/or Promoter.
28. If the Promoter cancels, modifies or suspends the Competition and invalidates any affected entries, suspends, modifies or replaces the Prize, or disqualifies your entry for any reason contemplated in these Terms, the Promoter is not responsible or liable for any losses incurred by you in these circumstances.

#### **Intellectual property rights and image rights**

29. Any entries and materials you submit to the Promoter in connection with this Competition are licensed to the Promoter on a non-exclusive, perpetual, irrevocable, sub-licensable, worldwide, royalty free basis.
30. You consent to the Promoter using your entry, name, likeness, image, voice and/or participation in the Prize in any media worldwide without notification or compensation for the purpose of promoting the Competition, its outcome, and/or any products or services manufactured, distributed and/or supplied by the Promoter.

32. 33. By participating in the Competition, participants release and hold harmless the Promoter, as well as the USTA, its Sections and District Organizations, USTA National Tennis Center Incorporated, the City of New York, each of their respective subsidiaries and affiliates and the directors, officers, employees or agents of any of the above organizations (collectively, the "Releasees") from any and all liability or any injuries, loss or damage of any kind arising from or in connection with participation in this Competition or acceptance, use, misuse or nonuse of any prize or parts thereof (including, without limitation, activity or travel related thereto), including, without limitation, liability for death, personal injury, damage or loss of any kind, and from liability to any other persons relating to or resulting from entering or downloading materials or software in connection with this Competition. Prizes are provided "AS IS." The Releasees do not make any warranty, representation,

or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or in law, relative to the use of any prize, including, without limitation, quality, merchantability, and fitness for a particular purpose. 36. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this Competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. In the event of any inconsistency, these Terms and Conditions shall prevail.
37. The laws of Victoria, Australia apply to this Promotion to the exclusion of any other law, except to the extent that such laws cannot be excluded. Participants submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Victoria, Australia.

#### **General**

38. Notwithstanding any provision of the above, the USTA is not a sponsor of this Competition and is not responsible for the administration of the Competition, the collection of the entries, the or the conduct of any drawing and selection of Winners.
